START TIME: Noon

Camp does not open until Sunday morning and is available on Sunday night; if teams want to arrive in advance of that, they **MUST** contact race management in advance. Camp has horse stalls, showers and fire rings.



DIRECTIONS TO CAMP:

From I-10, take the Alabama or Orange exits in the City of Redlands (east of I-215) and go north to Lagonia Avenue (SR38). Go NE on SR38 for approximately 31 miles to FS road 1N02 and make a right. At this turn there is a sign that says Heart Bar Campground, Wild Horse Equestrian and Heart Bar Equestrian Group Camp. Continue about ¼ mile up the dirt road to the Heart Bar Equestrian Group camp on the left (past Heart Bar Family campground on the right and the Wild Horse individual horse camp on the left).

From Big Bear Lake, go east to Big Bear City and turn right onto SR38 heading up to Onyx Summit. ~6.5 miles down from Onyx Summit make a left on FS road 1N02. Follow directions above.

From the Mojave Desert, go up Hwy 18 past Cushenbury Summit and turn left on Baldwin Lake Road, go around Baldwin Lake and turn left on SR 38 heading up to Onyx Summit...follow directions above.
