

CHESAPEAKE SPRING RIDE & TIE

12/25 MILE RIDE & TIES

APRIL 2-3, 2010

LOCATION: Beautiful Fair Hill DNR, Maryland, upper barn area

VETTING: Friday afternoon at 2 pm and Saturday at 7 AM. Clinic vetting begins at 7 AM. The 12 Mile clinic start as soon as all horses are vetted in.

ENTRY: 12/25 Mile Ride & Tie: \$50 per team by March 27. No refunds after March 29. ALL RIDE & TIE PARTICIPANTS MUST BE MEMBERS OF THE RIDE AND TIE ASSOCIATION. Membership \$25 for individual or \$40 for family. Separate Check to Ride and Tie Association. Clinics: \$30.

Overnight stall and camping: \$38 per night (arrangements made through ride management by March 24th (\$25 cleaning deposit held until stall is cleaned)

DETAILS: The Ride & Tie events are sanctioned by the Ride and Tie Association and will be conducted according to the Ride and Tie Association rules. Helmets are required when mounted.

ELIGIBILITY: RIDE & TIE horses must be at least 5 years old to participate. Current negative coggins must accompany your ride entry or be provided at check-in.

JUDGING: In accordance with rules and regulations of the RIDE AND TIE ASSOCIATION, it is the responsibility of all riders to know these rules. Rules will be posted at registration and are available at www.rideandtie.org

FOOD: Donuts and coffee Saturday am, and lunch Saturday afternoon for all competitors. On-trail snacks and beverages.

DIRECTIONS TO FAIR HILL:

From the South: Take I-95 North to Exit 100 (Route 272), turn left off the ramp toward Rising Sun. Continue to the traffic signal (Calvert) and turn right (east) on Route 273. Go approximately six miles. Fair Hill is on the right. Most Horse trailers find it easier to enter Fair Hill using Entry #2 which is just to the side of the grandstand.

From the Northeast: (New Jersey Turnpike or I-95 South) After crossing the Delaware Memorial Bridge, take the first Maryland exit. It is marked 279 Elkton (south) in Oxford. DO NOT TAKE 279 NEWARK! Follow Route 279 and turn left onto Maryland Route 213. Continue to the traffic signal at Maryland 273 and turn right. Fair Hill is on the right.

From the North: Take Pennsylvania Turnpike (I-76) to Route 202 South. Follow Route 202 to Route 1 south and turn right. Continue on Route 1 to the exit for Route 10 (south) in Oxford. In Oxford, turn right (south onto Route 472 which becomes Route 213 in Maryland. Continue to traffic signal at Maryland Route 273 and turn right. Fair Hill is on the right.

From the West: Take I-70 or I-83 to I-695 to I-95 North to Ext 100 (Route 272). Turn left off the ramp toward Rising Sun. Continue to the traffic signal (Calvert) and turn right (east) on Route 273. Go approximately six miles. Fair Hill is on the right. Most Horse trailers find it easier to enter Fair Hill using Entry #2 which is just to the side of the grandstand.
