

FORT STANTON RIDE & TIE

Fort Stanton, New Mexico

July 15, 17, 19, and 21

July 15, 19 are 35 miles and July 17, 21 are 25 or 25 miles.

BASE CAMP: Base camp is located in a large open meadow at 6,200 feet elevation on BLM land. There are restrooms and porta-potties. Potable water will be available throughout camp. Each ride entry includes the evening meal the day of the ride. Coffee, rolls and breakfast burritos will be available for purchase each morning. Base Camp is about 4 miles from Capitan, New Mexico, home of Smokey the Bear, where there are stores, restaurants, hotel and gas station. Expect warm days and cool nights. July is the start of the rainy season and there may be afternoon clouds and thunder showers.

TRAILS: Each day of the race is on different trails. Some are on two track roads, others cross rolling hills and open meadows. Water is available on the trails about every 5-10 miles and at all vet checks.

ENTRY: Entry for the Ride & Tie races is \$100 per team per day for entries postmarked by June 27, 2011. Add \$10 for later entries. All Ride & Tie Competitors **MUST** be members of the Ride & Tie Association. One year Ride & Tie membership is \$25. Make these checks payable to Ride and Tie Association. Make entry fee checks payable to Roger Taylor. Send them along with the entry blank to Roger Taylor. Entry blanks can be found at www.aerc.org.
