(In conjunction with the Foxcatcher 50/25 Mile Endurance Ride)

**\* All Ride & Tie competitors must be members of the Ride & Tie Association.**

**Base Camp:** Camp is open from Thursday, April 15<sup>th</sup> through Sunday, April 18<sup>th</sup>. This is an open field with no electric and no campfires permitted. Dogs must be on leash at all times and confined when people are away from camp.

**Trails:** Good footing. Some single track through woods, some big grass fields, plenty of hills, some (mostly dirt) roads. No public highways. Lots of water on trail.

**Holds:** All holds will be in Base Camp. Crews will have access to riders/runners at several designated locations throughout the course

#### **Directions:**

From North: I-95 or NJ Turnpike South over the Delaware Memorial Bridge. Exit 109A (Route 279 towards Elkton) to Route 213. Turn right onto Route 213 North. Right onto Big Elk Chapel Road. 1 mile to Base Camp.

From South: I-95 to Exit 100. Left off ramp onto Route 272 North. Five miles to Route 273. Turn right onto Route 273 East. Cross lighted intersection at Route 273/Route 213. Fair Hill Inn will be on the right. 1 mile to Gallaher Road on the right. Turn right onto Gallaher Road. 1 mile to Base Camp.
