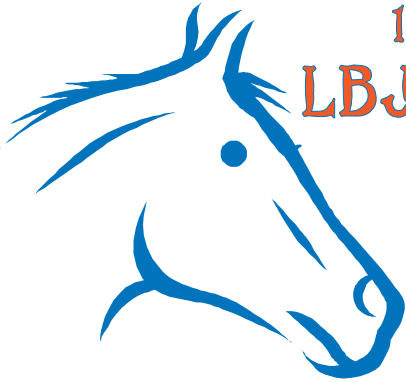


FREEZ'R BURN RIDE & TIE

Campsite: TADRA Point Campsite is a primitive camp ground with plenty of parking for all size rigs. Only water is from pond at campsite, so haul water in if you do not want to haul it from a pond. This is a pack in, pack out site. Dogs **MUST** be kept on leashes or owners will be fined by US Forest Service.

Trails: Native woods and prairie. Terrain is generally flat and footing is grass or soil. These are permanently marked trails. Trails are relatively flat and horses have done this trail barefooted with smart riding. There is plenty of horse water out on trail.

Entry Fees: 10 distance: \$50.00 per team. 25 distance: \$60.00 per team. All competitors must be members of the Ride and Tie Association. Membership forms available at ride or on website at www.rideandtie.org. Make checks for membership (\$25 for individual competitors/\$40 for families) to Ride and Tie Association.

Please include: ride fees, copies of coggins test results, current Ride and Tie Association number. Your check-in times will be much quicker if you pre-register!!!

Schedule: Sunday, February 14, 8:00 Ride & Tie start for all distances

Directions for Dallas: I-35E north to I-35 in Denton continue north exit Highway 380W to Decatur, you will go west 24 miles to FM 730 (signs also say Airport) then go north 9.5 mile to CR 2461 (sign will also say Cemetery), 100 yards turn right on CR 2560 follow CR 2560 2.3 mile to road 900 (sign will say Cottonwood Lake) turn left it is then 1.8 miles to camp at TADRA Point.
