


Old Glory Ride & Tie

25 miles and 10 miles
Dripping Springs, Texas
May 30, 2010



Directions from Dallas:

Travel on Highway 290 into Dripping Springs, turn south on North Ranch Road 12, go approximately six miles and look for signs to ride camp on your right.

Ride Location and Campsite:

Storm Ranch is a 6000 acre working cattle ranch. It is the largest contiguous ranch in this part of Texas. Several creeks and streams run through this beautiful property. From a few hill top locations, you will be able to see the Devil's Backbone located over 20 miles to the South. Camp is primitive. No hook ups are available. Horse water will be available at the cooling area and located in camp areas. Please bring potable water for human consumption. There will be separate generator and non-generator areas. Portable toilets will be stationed in the camping areas.

Trails:

Loops will largely utilize existing ranch trails and roads. Some single track stretches are present. Water crossings should be anticipated. Trails are generally compacted earth with some interspersed rock. Expect some hill work, occasional rocky trail and asphalt stretches. Shoes are recommended.

Water: Water on trail will be natural streams and/or troughs. No sponging from troughs will be allowed. Separate sponge buckets will be provided if possible. Human water will be provided in locations on trail.

Entry Fees:

10 distance: \$50.00 per team. 25 distance: \$60.00 per team. All competitors must be members of the Ride and Tie Association. Membership forms available at ride or on website at www.rideandtie.org. Make checks for membership (\$25 for individual competitors/\$40 for families) to Ride and Tie Association.

Please include: ride fees, copies of coggins test results, current Ride and Tie Association number. Your check-in times will be much quicker if you pre-register!!!

6:30 – 25-mile start

8:00 – 10-mile start
