

# QUICKSILVER RIDE & TIE SAN JOSE, CA

MAY 15, 2010  
6, 11 AND 22 MILE COURSES



**RACE SITE INFORMATION:** Human and horse water and porta-potties will be available. Services available from the race site. Supermarket - 5 miles; feed and tack store - 2 miles; restaurant - 300 yards (really nice one) 5 miles for one that allows blue jeans. Please clean all trash, hay, and manure using garbage bags. Park regulations prohibit alcohol. Dogs are allowed but must be on a leash or in an enclosure at all times. Camping will be in the overflow parking area at the Hacienda entrance. By 9PM Friday night, there will be a combination lock on the gate at the entrance to the main parking lot. For Friday night camping I will ask for a camping donation as the Santa Clara County Parks charges a camping fee.

**COURSE INFORMATION:** Hard packed dirt fire road for most of the trail. All finish down a single track trail. The 22 mile course is twice the 11 mile course. Keep It Simple!

**ENTRY:** \$130 for the 22 mile race, \$110 for the 11 mile, and \$50 for the 6 mile. All competitors **MUST** be current members of the Ride and Tie Association. Membership \$25

#### DIRECTIONS TO RACE SITE:

From the north: 680 South turns into 280. Exit on 87 South (Guadalupe Parkway). Take 85 West to the first exit, Almaden Parkway South \*

From the south: from 101 North, take 85 West to Mountain View. Exit on Almaden Expressway South\*. \*The final directions from both north and south: on Almaden Expressway go south about 4 miles and turn right onto Almaden Road (traffic signal). Follow Almaden Road approximately 3 miles to the Hacienda entrance of the Almaden Quicksilver Park on the right. Drive through the parking lot into the large grassy field. Look for the Quicksilver Ride & Tie banner.
