Course Description: The race will leave from Sunrise Canyon Estates, a rural area just a few miles outside of Kennewick, WA. The terrain is mostly desert trail with some dirt road and about 1 mile of soft gravel road. One large hill and nice views along ridgeline. Footing is good, not many rocks compared to most rides, sometimes sandy. Scenery is desert and agricultural with some houses in the distance. Ties will be mostly sage brush, some telephone poles. Ties will be less plentiful than most rides but still adequate with some forethought. Perfect introductory R&T for first timers!

Schedule: Saturday March 24, 2012. Vet checks will be from 7am to 9am. Race time is 10am. Weather permitting we will BBQ, socialize, play guitars, etc. following the race.

Logistics: Ride camp will be in a large pasture, plenty of room for those coming in Friday night to camp, tie horses, etc. Horse water will be available.

Fees Per individual: Race Fee is \$25. All participants must also be Ride & Tie Association members to participate (for insurance purposes). Ride & Tie yearly membership is \$25 per person or \$40 per family.

Directions: The nearest intersection that will show up on navigation devices or Mapquest is the corner of S. Burmuda Rd and E. Reata Rd in Kennewick, WA. Ridecamp is approximately 2.5 miles west of this intersection continuing west on E. Reata Rd.
