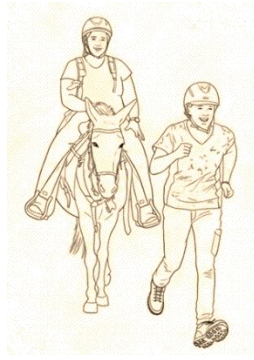


Giddy Up and Run 2026



Potentially Useful Information

Camping Facilities:

Giddy Up and Run is held at The East Fork Stables located at 3598 S York Hwy, Jamestown, TN 38556.

Overnight Camping (with electricity and water), Cabins, Stables, and high ties are all available at East Fork Stables. You must make your own arrangements with East Fork Stables and sign their release forms.

This event will be headquartered at Campground D and Barn E.

To make reservations call 1-800-978-7245 or 931-879-1176. The office is usually open M-F 9-3 CST

You may use other offsite accommodations for horses or people; just be sure to arrive in time for the start of the race.

Trails:

The East Fork Stables have about 125 miles of exclusively equestrian trails consisting of dirt/gravel roads, and some single-track trails.

Food and Water: You must bring ALL food and snacks for people and horses. Restaurants are available in Jamestown, about 15 minutes away. No meals or snacks will be provided. Ice is available at the stables. Horse water is also available.

Distances: There will be Friday race distances of 4, 7, 10, 15 and 28 miles on Friday and 4, 7, 10, 15, and 25 miles on Saturday. Short (4 or 7 mile) races can be arranged for afternoons if needed/requested. Equathon distances of 10 Ride/4 Run, 13 Ride/7 Run both days

Awards: Giddy Up and Run Ride and Tie t-shirts will be provided as completion awards-two shirts per team per event. We need to know sizes, (Mens or Womens adult or Youth S/M/L/XL) before **Saturday March 8, 2025**. If you want extra shirts for crew members (additional \$14/shirt) please indicate on the registration form. T-shirts are guaranteed for registrations received before **February 28**, so please send in your registration early!!!

Refund Policy: A refund minus a non-refundable deposit (\$30) will be granted if a rider/team cannot attend. Refunds will be processed within 30 days after the ride. Early registration is very much appreciated for planning purposes.

Acknowledgement of Risk & Release of Liability

As a participant in the Giddy Up and Run Ride & Tie and Equathon, I agree to abide by the rules of Ride & Tie, race management, race veterinarians, and East Fork Stables.

I understand that Ride & Tie involves being in areas that have many natural and human-made hazards which ride management cannot and declines to anticipate, identify, modify, or eliminate; that Ride & Tie involves being in remote areas for extended periods of time, away from communications, transportation, and medical facilities; that horses can be excitable, difficult to control, and unpredictable; that as a result of participating in the Giddy Up and Run Ride & Tie and/or Equathon, my horse or I may be injured, die, or my property damaged; and that accidents can happen to anyone at any time. It is expressly understood by the undersigned that Ride Management, all involved property owners, and all ride personnel will not endeavor to mark any and all hidden, obvious or potential hazards but will merely mark the trail to be used. I agree to take full responsibility for the animal that I am riding and myself. I will hold the ride management, all ride personnel, and all property owners over whose land the ride crosses blameless for any accident, injury, or loss that might occur due to my participation in the Giddy Up and Run Ride & Tie and Equathon and free from all liability for such injury or loss. In consideration for permission to enter and participate in the Giddy Up and Run Ride & Tie and Equathon, I do hereby for myself and my heirs release and hold harmless race management, race personnel, all property owners over whose land the ride crosses, The Ride & Tie Association, their agents, officers, servants, employees and officials, from all claims, demands, actions and causes of any kind, for injury or death sustained by me or my horse, and damage to my property, incurred during this ride, arising from negligence or any other fault. The foregoing release applies to me and to any junior who I sponsor. This release becomes effective immediately upon my arrival at East Fork Stables and remains in effect until I (we) have completely left these facilities/grounds.

In the event the rider is incapacitated, I agree to allow the veterinarians to reserve judgement in treating my horse in order to stabilize its condition. I agree to pay the veterinarians for these services.
